## Study Abroad Award

-Applicants must have completed Sociology 100 with the textbook Sociology: A Global Perspective.

-Applicants must be NKU students in good standing who have already completed one semester at NKU at the time of application.

-Preference will be given to short-term (1-2 week) programs.

- Students in any academic discipline are eligible to apply.

- As part of the application, each student must submit the following documents:

1. an essay explaining how the Intro to Sociology class and the textbook, Sociology: A Global Perspective, will enhance his/her understanding and willingness to be an informed, receptive, and contributing participant in the world beyond the classroom.
2. an official transcript

Awards of varying amounts up to \$1,000 will be available.

The applicant(s) chosen to receive this award may have the opportunity to have a photograph, essay, or journal entry from his/her study abroad experience published in a subsequent edition of the textbook, Sociology: A Global Perspective.
