An exciting study abroad opportunity to Japan is currently being sponsored by NKU's Office of Education Abroad and our university exchange partner, Nanzan University. Students will have the opportunity to spend time in Japan studying the major cultural environment in which a majority of Japanese people have lived during the last half century. Students will receive credit for POP 345 or POP 499 as an Independent Study. This program will be led by Professor Yasue Kuwahara of the Department of Communications.



Participants will stay at Nanzan University in Nagoya. Nagoya is the fourth largest city in central Japan. The city is known for its unique cultural style as well as for its international outreach. There will also be plenty of opportunities for NKU students to interact with Japanese students.

Participants will also spend one week outside of Nagoya traveling to Tokyo to experience Japanese popular culture, such as Akihabara, Shibuya, and Hayao Miyazaki's Ghibli Museum. Participants will also travel to Kyoto, Osaka, and Hiroshima.
