



STUDY ABROAD IN

MEXICO

This Winter Break, NKU students will have an exciting opportunity to study abroad in Guadalajara, México. This program is currently being sponsored by the NKU Honors Program and open to Honors students. Students will have the opportunity to spend one week learning the art of doing business in México. Students will also be introduced to the business sector of México, the economy, and Mexican culture.



Honors students will have the opportunity to experience Mexican customs, culture, and food firsthand during the planned excursions. Students will also participate in planned tourism activities.

This program is open to Honors students, especially those with business or Mexican culture interests.
